| <p>Decide on possible dates for the election, and seek permission</p> <p>Tip: Look at dates at least three weeks away to give yourselves time to plan. Find more than one possible election date. That way, if somebody spots a problem with your first-choice date, you'll have a back-up.</p> | <p>Plan a 5 minute 'pitch' for your headteacher:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Introduce the idea of a Value election to determine which of the seven Olympic and Paralympic Values is most important to your school. <p>Courage Determination Friendship Respect Inspiration Excellence Equality</p> <p>Volunteers will canvass for each Value and enlist support; they'll make campaign speeches or year group assemblies and distribute leaflets.
